<u>Set-Up</u>. Debi Harding reported that the racks we purchased from Sew-E-Z fit into the shed. The contents of the shed need to be inventoried.

<u>Silent Auction</u>. The committee is busy at chapter meetings accepting donations of items for the silent auction and baskets and containers to display the auction items. It was determined that eight (8) tables will be needed at the Show for Silent Auction.

<u>Special Exhibits and Workshops</u>. Debbie Coleman reported that Special Exhibits planning to include the Virginia Quilt Museum and a junior quilters "Kids Can Sew" project. Other exhibits will be: Quilts of Valor, Linus and Memory Quilts. It was decided not to invite other guilds to exhibit at our show.

There was discussion about the Workshop pricing. Perhaps a VIP pricing for taking both workshops. More information to be discussed at the November meeting.

<u>Registration</u>. Gray Castro and Ruth Nixon presented the new Registration Form. *The revised draft is attached*. The width and length will be switched. The form will be finalized and ready for the website by November. It was suggested that podium facetime will be needed at chapter meetings.

Door Prizes. Nothing to report at this time.

<u>Ribbons</u>. Debbie Williams and her bee will be creating the ribbons. There will be 1<sup>st</sup> place, 2<sup>nd</sup> place for each category. In addition there will be Best of Show and Viewer's Choice. The Judge will bring her own Judge's Choice award to be conferred if she chooses.

<u>Committee Quilt</u>. Lola McCracken reported that the piecing of the blocks will be completed by November and delivered to Christie for quilting. It was decided there would be no red thread on the quilt.

Appraiser and Judge. Jane Ann reported that all contracts are signed. The judging will be held on Monday, August 13.

We welcomed Buffy Fauber to the committee.

You may think of your family home, your home of origin, a foster home, a broken home, a home ravaged by natural disaster, a historic home that you love, the home of a friend or beloved pet. Turn that thought into a quilt. You can be quite literal (an applique of the White House in D.C.) or symbolic (a log cabin block in your mother's favorite colors).

Let your heart guide your hands!

## **2018 TQG CHALLENGE RULES:**

- Start by purchasing a package of the challenge fabrics (four fat eighths) for \$5.00 at any guild meeting. You must use some of each of these fabrics although the amount is left to your vision and imagination; you will supplement the project with fabrics from your stash.
- \* Each entry can not exceed 80" indiameter. Perimeter Sie eve of a Sort.
- \* You may use any technique or combination of techniques to illustrate your story.
- ❖ Each entry must be accompanied by a 3" x 5" index card briefly explaining what personal story is portrayed in your challenge quilt and include only your guild number as identification (i.e. no name or email address).
- \* Each entry must have a label sewn to the back of the challenge, including membership number and EITHER telephone number or email address.

  All entries must be submitted no later than \_\_\_\_\_\_\_2018 at any TQG chapter meeting. Rose form
- Winners will be selected by popular vote of Quilt Show attendees. Any effort to influence the popular vote, overtly or covertly, brought to the attention of the Quilt Show Committee will be cause for immediate disqualification.
- Challenge Prizes: \$100.00 gift card for First Place; \$75.00 gift card for Second Place; \$50.00 gift card for Third Place.
